

IN-PERSON FILING Form to Accompany an Application for a Possession and Acquisition Licence for Restricted or Prohibited Firearms

Note: Please use block letters.

IMPORTANT (to be read by the applicant for a licence)

- > The applicant must present themselves to the police station serving his territory of residence and bring with him this form that must be completed by a police officer, and a VALID IDENTITY PAPER WITH PHOTO and PROOF OF ADDRESS.
- > After the police officer has completed the form, the applicant must attach it to his application for a possession and acquisition licence for restricted or prohibited firearms and send it along with other required documents to the following address:

IMPORTANT (to be read by the police officer completing the form)

- > The Chief Firearms Officer serve in that capacity for all Quebec police forces according to the designation granted to him by the Ministère de la Sécurité publique.
- According to existing requirements, only a police officer from the police station serving the applicant's territory of residence may complete this form. This form is to be used for all new applications for a restricted firearm licence or to upgrade a licence to allow the acquisition of restricted or prohibited firearms. For more information, a Sûreté du Québec police officer can consult the instruction Valider et transmettre les renseignements pertinents accompagnant une demande de permis de possession et acquisition d'armes à feu au contrôleur des armes à feu available on the intranet under the tab Sur le terrain > Armes à feu et explosifs. A police officer from a municipal police department can consult the "Communiqué numéro 2013-20" from the Ministère de la Sécurité publique.
