



IDENTIFICATION AND SECURITY CLEARANCE OUTSIDE CANADA FOR A GENERAL EXPLOSIVES PERMIT APPLICATION

1. INSTRUCTIONS

You must comply with the necessary requirements if you are:

- › an applicant from outside Canada for a general explosives permit – Individual;
- › a director or a shareholder from outside Canada and holding 10% or more of the shares with full voting rights for a company that applies for a general explosives permit.

This form and all the documents specified at section 2 must be join, depending of the case, to the *Application for a general explosives permit – Individual* (SQ-3106A) or the *Application for a general explosives permit – Company* (SQ-3104A).

The information obtained will only be use by the Sûreté du Québec for the purposes of the general explosives permit application.

2. NECESSARY REQUIERMENTS

Present yourself to your local police station where a police officer will:

- › formally identify you;
- › complete a criminal record check or a certificate of good conduct, which will be given to you;
- › write your surname, name, date of birth and sign the back of both photographs (for an individual application only);
- › complete section 3.
